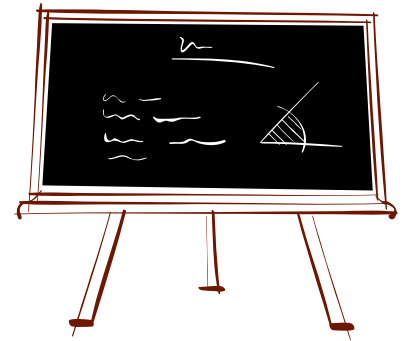
The HAPPY Hour Student Showcase!
